Sinus instructions following teeth removal

The roots of your upper teeth had grown through bone and into your sinus. Following their removal, an opening into the antrum was visible. This opening will usually close without complications; however, you may help by following these instructions:

- 1. Please take prescribed antibiotic tablets as directed as they are essential to prevent infection.
- 2. Refrain from sneezing through the nose. Open mouth sneezes are required during the healing process.
- 3. Do not inhale deeply on a pipe or cigar, blow or spit vigorously or suck through a straw.
- 4. Avoid blowing your nose, although some discharge containing blood for the first few days may be expected. (Bloody nose)

Strict adherence to these instructions may prevent the necessity of a surgical closure in the future.
